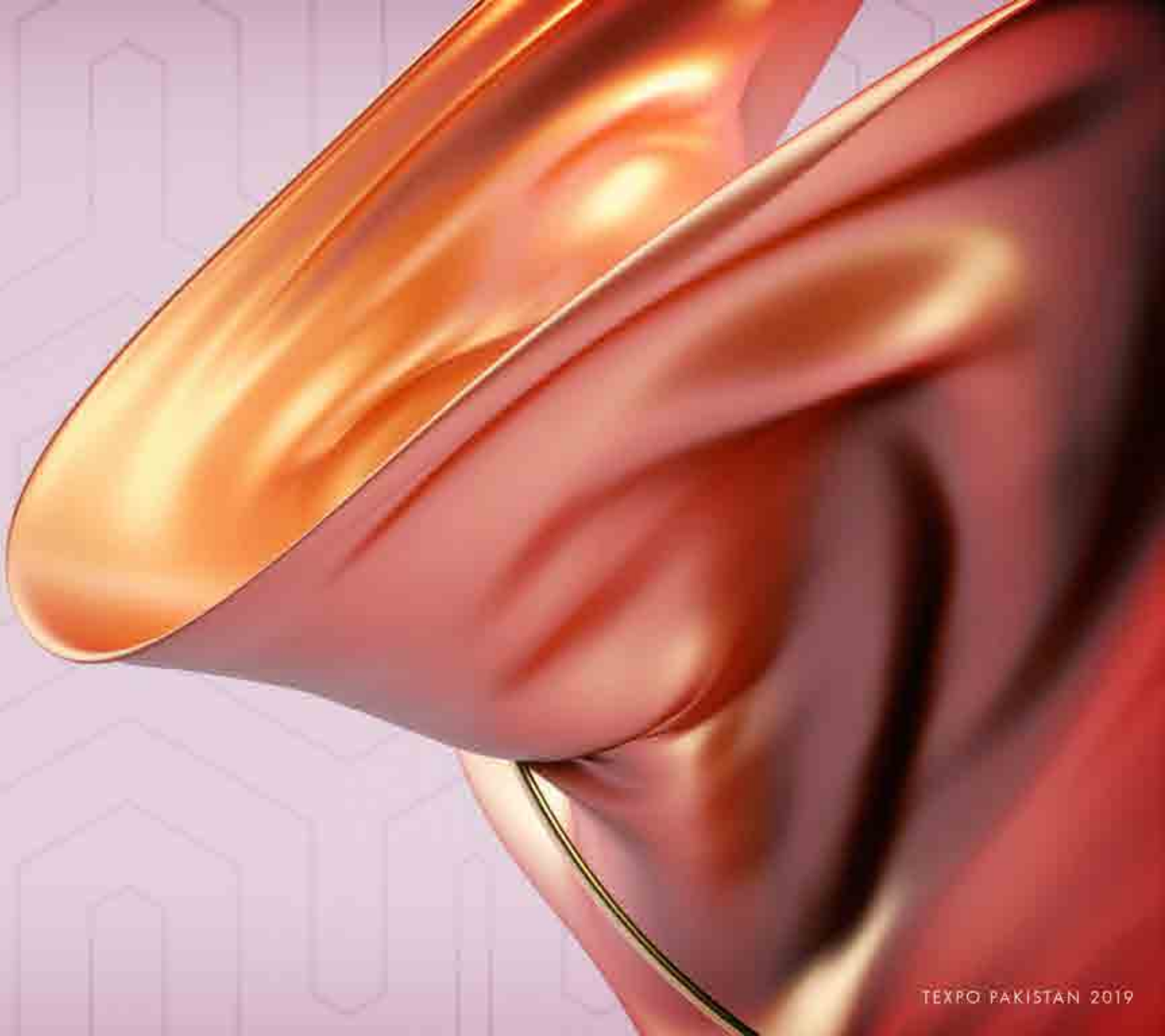

-  Pakistan is the 4th largest producer of cotton in the world.
-  Textile is the most important manufacturing sector of Pakistan and has the longest production chain.
-  The origin of textiles is considered to be the Indus Valley Civilization situated in Pakistan!
-  There are about 10,000 Towel Looms in Pakistan.
-  There are 5,000 Readymade Garments units, 1,200 Knitwear units, 750 Processing/Finishing units & 1,200 Ginning factories in Pakistan.
-  Textiles comprise 62% of Pakistan's export revenues.

-  The sector contributes nearly one-fourth industrial value-added, provides employment to about 40% of industrial labor force.
-  Readymade garment industry has emerged as one of the important small scale industries in Pakistan.
-  The main products manufactured by the woollen industry are carpets and rugs.

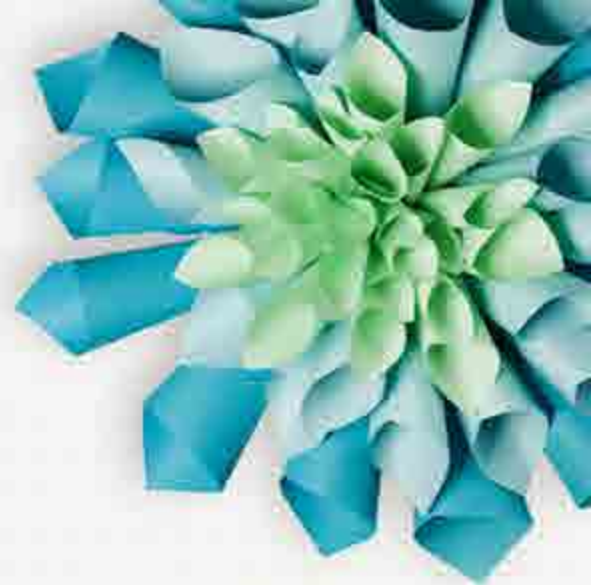
Emerging Pakistan
